## ADVANCED PROCEDURES

- Diagnostic and therapeutic ERCP
  - Biliary/pancreatic strictures, stones, leaks, pancreas divisum
  - Spyglass, biliary RFA, photodynamic and laser therapy
  - Ampullectomy
  - Rendezvous, hepaticogastrostomy, choledochoduodenostomy
- Diagnostic and therapeutic EUS (upper and lower)
  - Staging and biopsy of malignancies and sub-epithelial lesions
  - Fiducial placement
  - Celiac plexus block and neurolysis
  - Gastric varices (coiling/glue)
  - Liver biopsy, venous gradient measurement
  - Drainage of peripancreatic and post-surgical collections
  - EUS directed transgastric ERCP (EDGE)
  - EUS-guided gallbladder drainage
- Obesity management
  - Endoscopic sleeve gastropasty (ESG)
  - Transoral Outlet Reduction (TORe)
  - Endoscopic balloon placement
- Motility-related disorders, GERD directed therapies, gastroparesis
  - POEM (esophageal, gastric, Zenker's and other diverticula)
  - Pneumatic dilation for achalasia/strictures
  - Transoral Incisionless Fundoplication (TIF®)
  - Anti-reflux mucosectomy (ARMS)
  - Esophageal manometry, endoflip
  - Bravo® pH study and pH-impedance testing
- Premalignant lesions/polyps and early-stage cancers
  - Resection of lesions: EMR, ESD, EFTR and STER
  - Barrett's treatment (RFA, cryotherapy, resection)
- Enteral access
  - Enteral stenting, EUS-guided gastroenterostomy
  - Balloon-assisted enteroscopy (antegrade/retrograde)
- Other
  - Post-surgical fistulas/leaks, endovacuum therapy
  - Shock wave lithotripsy of pancreatic stones
  - Feeding tubes: PEG, PEJ, PEG-J, PEG with T-fasteners, NJ
